

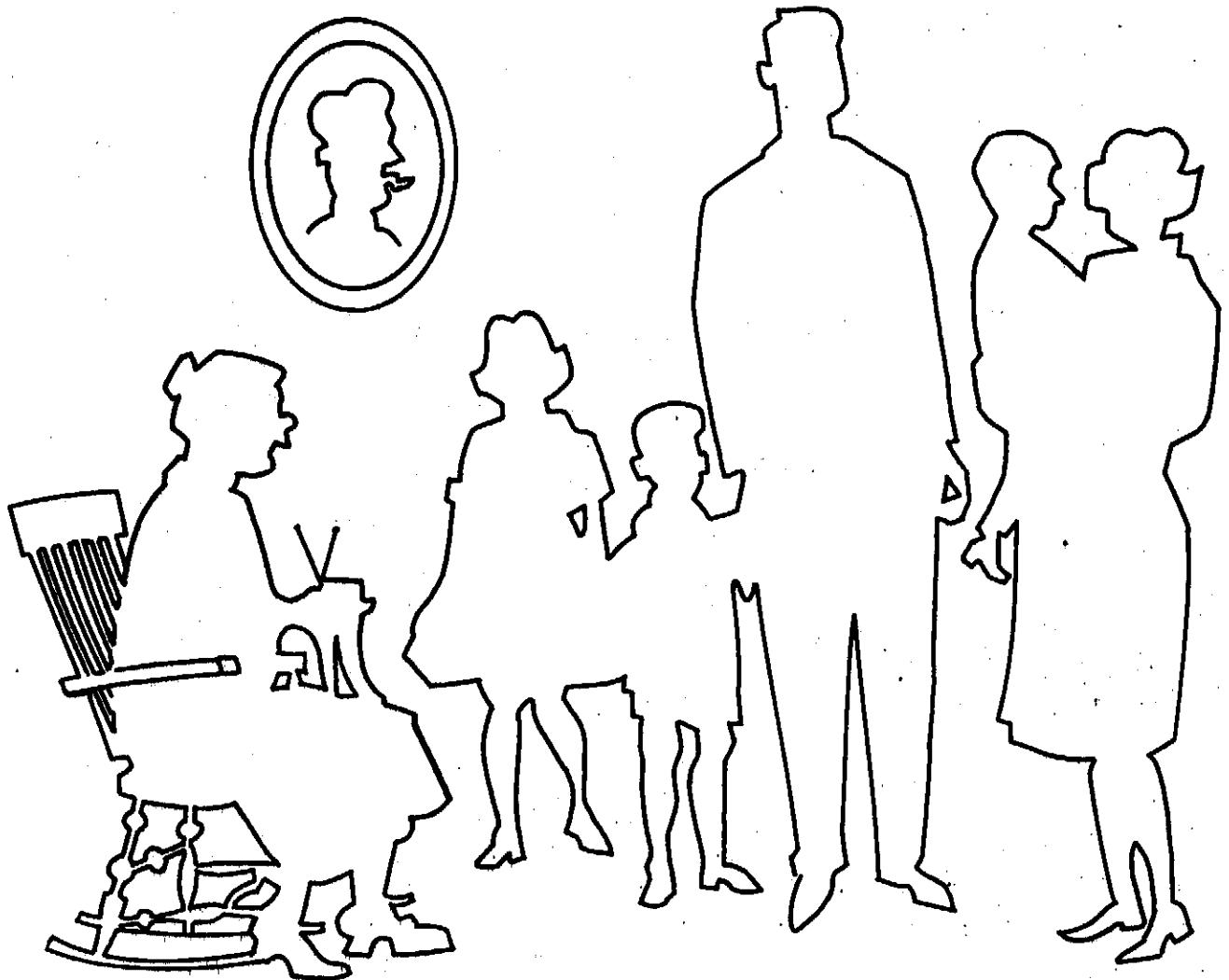

A hundred years ago Maud Ellen Duff Burnett, a widow, with several of her children, among which was a married son whose wife was a former Miss Dieane Wallace, left Giles County, Tennessee, in a covered wagon headed for Arkansas.

Where they crossed the Mississippi River has not been revealed, but they did make it to Arkansas is a known fact. Mrs. Burnett wrote a letter to her daughter, Katie, who had been left with a friend, that the party had arrived at Marvell Station in Phillips County, Ark. The letter was dated January 18, 1872. It was the last ever heard from any member of the family.

Beside the married son, Narvern, and two sisters, Sis and Frances Burnett, there were two or three small boys in the party whose names have faded from memory down the years.

Katie grew to be a young lady and married David Crockett Neal and lived on a farm seven miles south from Pulaski, Tenn. Though Katie Burnett Neal was a busy farm mother, she always grieved about what could have happened to her family. She always bore anxiety for the whereabouts of her mother and brothers and sisters, even as a little girl while she stayed in the home of Bob Barber with whom her mother left her.

She voiced this anxiety to her children as they grew to adults, and now her great-granddaughter, Annie Neal Wilkinson, is trying to locate these displaced relatives. The thrill of a lifetime would come to Neal Burnett if someone in Arkansas who is a Burnett or know of this family of Burnetts would write her:
