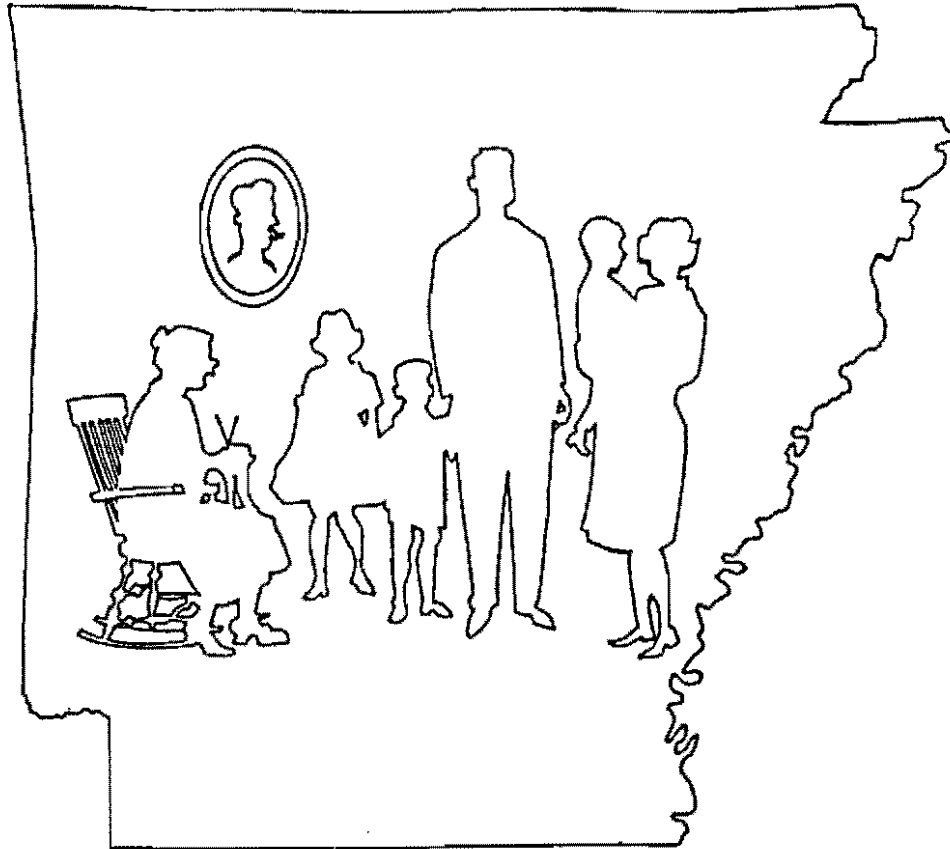

NEW HISTORICAL SOCIETY QUARTERLY: The good folks at the Montgomery County, Arkansas, Historical Society, P. O. Box 520, Mount Ida, AR 71957, have begun publication of quarterly entitled THE CRYSTAL. It is now in the second number of Volume One. According to its masthead it is "Clear, Sparkling and to the Point". Membership in the organization and copies of THE CRYSTAL costs \$5.00 per year. Queries may be submitted by members. Non-members may submit at the rate of \$1.00 per query. The organization is now preparing to publish Volume II of their successful MONTGOMERY COUNTY OUR HERITAGE. "Our production crew for Volume II is busy processing family histories and other stories as they arrive", according to Debbie Baldwin, President. Although the June 1989 issue is less than 15 pages long, it contains a listing of Montgomery County loose probate papers available through the organization, listings from the Bucktown Cemetery on Lake Ouachita, and a page of queries. Sharon Taylor and Halbert's, Inc., of Bath, Ohio, are again being investigated following a consent agreement they had breached from a prior legal hearing in 1985. The newest petition alleges that the company continues to misrepresent its product.

We've been told that the State of Texas closed some birth and death records, effective 09/01/87 through the passage of HB768 in the 10th Session of the State Legislature, and that copies, when available, are now \$7.50 each. It is also reported Texas genealogists are working on this problem.

Vera Sanford Rock of Rt. 5, Box 362, Spokane, WA 99208, wrote: "I was so happy to see the article about the 'Hawkins' cemetery near Atoka, Oklahoma, in the June issue of the Arkansas Family Historian.

"I am enclosing a copy of the service record of John E. Flowers who enlisted in October 1861 in Antoine (not Antonia) Arkansas in C. L. Dawson's 9th Arkansas Division, Company A. We have been trying for a long time to locate the place where he was buried. We have known for some time that he died at Muddy Boggy, Oklahoma.

"John E. Flowers was the mother of my grandmother, Turie Jane Flowers (Turie was spelled many ways- Turia-Ture-Tura, etc.) who married William A. Anderson (called Joe) and they lived on a farm on the Little River just outside Alleene, Arkansas.

"John E. Flowers was one of the soldiers who died of a 'sickness' as it is described in his service record. He was born in South Carolina, his wife was Nancy Ann Brown, they were married in DeKalb County, Alabama. His parents raised his daughters. I do not know the fate of Nancy but is thought she died after the birth of Turie, but we do not know the date or cause of death.

"It was really wonderful find for the descendants of John E. Flowers. Thanks so much." (The copy of the service record is included here.)

The Journal
of
Rev. William Henry WOOD
1853 - 1907

The following information was taken from the pages of the journal of Rev. William Henry WOOD, a Methodist preacher, who pastored in Arkansas, Tennessee, Missouri, and Mississippi from 1850 until his death on Feb. 17, 1908. He settled in Marion county before the Civil War, near Flippin. During the War he moved to Missouri, but returned to the Flippin area afterwards. He is buried in the Hurst Cemetery at Flippin. The abstract was made by his great grandson, Tom L. WOOD, 1105 W. Kaweax, Visalia, Ca 93277. It is mostly a list of marriages performed by Rev. WOOD, together with some additional information. The amount of money listed after the grooms name is the amount paid to Rev. WOOD for the ceremony. Only the marriages, membership, and baptisms are reported here.

THE STORY OF THE WILLIAM HENRY WOOD FAMILY (1825-1908, PRESENT)

William Henry WOOD

Born: December 31, 1825, in the state of Alabama.

Died: November 3, 1918, in Flippin, Arkansas (Age 83 years, 2 months, 17 days).
Buried in the Hurst Cemetery, Flippin, Arkansas.

Married: In Marion County, State of Arkansas, 6 3/4 Mile below Yellville, Arkansas, to

Louisa Jane Reynolds, on October 15, 1858.

Born: February 28, 1835, in State of Tennessee.

Died: November 3, 1918, in Flippin, Marion County, Arkansas (Age 83 years, 9 months, 4 days).

Hurst Cemetery, Flippin, Arkansas.

William Henry WOOD was ordained an Elder of the Methodist Episcopal Church on November 2, 1856.

Children:

1. John Martin WOOD - born 1859, Marion County, Arkansas, moved to Texas.
2. Ann E. WOOD - born 1861, Marion County, Arkansas.
3. James Perry WOOD - born 18 Sep 1862, at McBee's Landing, Barry County, Missouri. They had 10 children.

4. William E. WOOD - born Barry County, Missouri, married Mary M. Burch, 18 Dec 1890 on White River, Marion County, Arkansas. Died 12 Dec 1945 at the age of 81 years, 3 months, 12 days, in Garvin County, Oklahoma. They left Arkansas in 1902.
5. Leroy WOOD - born 1865, Barry County, Missouri
6. Francis Marion WOOD - born 2 Oct 1868, in Missouri. Died 12 Jan 1919, Marion County, Arkansas.
7. Robert Pinkney WOOD - born 1875, Barry County, Missouri. Died 1955, Garvin County, Oklahoma. Married Sadie ?
8. Lou WOOD - married a man by the name of Bures.
9. Ira Cook WOOD (twin) - born 23 Nov 1872, Barry County, Missouri. Died 19 Jul 1942, Muskogee, Oklahoma (was run over by a car). Married at Flippin, Marion County, Arkansas, 24 Dec 1902, to Huldah (Doc) Burch (1882-1961). He lived 69 years, 6 months, 26 days and she lived 78 years, 9 months, 9 days. They had 5 children, they were: (1) Roy Dee WOOD (1904-1976), (2) Francis Eucl WOOD (1906-1979), (3) Harold James WOOD (1914-1962), (4) Nola WOOD (1909-1981), and my father Gerald Blaine WOOD (1923-1984).
10. Arminthia WOOD (twin) - born 23 Nov 1872, died in infancy.

William Henry WOOD only went to school 5 days in his life. He and his wife were in Flippin, Marion County, Arkansas before the Civil War. When the war broke out, he moved his family near Cassville, Barry County, Missouri. After the war, in 1877, he moved his family back to Marion County, Arkansas. He bought two log cabins, with a dog trot between them, and 160 acres of land.

William Henry farmed, taught school and preached from 1850 until 1908, when he died. He preached in Arkansas, Missouri, Tennessee, and Mississippi.

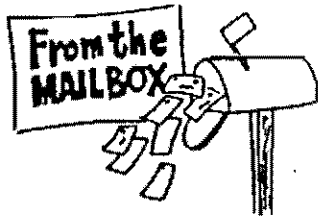

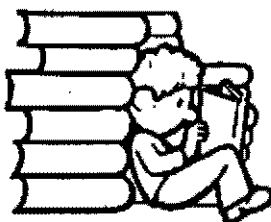

BOOK REVIEWS

Bobbie Jones McLane and Desmond Walls Allen

The following are reviews and/or announcements of book acquisitions for the Arkansas Genealogical Society. These books are permanently housed in the local History and Genealogy Room of the Little Rock Public Library. The Society expresses its appreciation to the authors and contributors. In ordering copies of these books, please remember to say you saw the review in this publication.

MARRIAGE RECORDS MONROE COUNTY, ARKANSAS, BOOK D, 1860-1877 by Jo Claire English, PO Box 206, Clarendon, AR 72029. Soft-cover, velo bind, 70 pp., surname index, \$10.00 postpaid. This book contains 1,082 marriages, with 31 credentials for ministers. It is the second oldest Monroe Co. marriage record in existence, and contains marriages from 8 Jan. 1860 thru 28 Nov. 1877. As it covers the Civil War period, the last entries during the war were recorded in 1862, when the courts were suspended and all records were removed and hidden until the courts resumed in July 1865. Although some of the marriage entries are brief, some contain names of parents, place of marriage and other helpful information. In one record (Jones to Sloat) the color of hair and eyes of the bride and groom were given. The index includes grooms, brides and ministers credentials. - BJM.

EARLY OUACHITA COUNTY, ARKANSAS, TAX RECORDS 1846-1860 by Yvonne Spence Perkins, 2107 54th, Lubbock, TX 79412, softbound, 202 pages, \$15 postpaid. Tax lists are such wonderful sources for genealogists and Mrs. Perkins has made these early lists for Ouachita County accessible in her book. Taxpayers are listed in alphabetical order (with an index to non-resident and original land owners) in tabular form. Personal and real taxes were combined in one assessment at this time in Arkansas and where land descriptions are given, even the quarter section is listed. The visual presentation of the material is especially well done. Helpful period maps enhance the book. Subsequent volumes containing the Ouachita County tax lists are in preparation by Mrs. Perkins and we applaud her efforts to make this little-known, little-used resource available.-DWA

GILES COUNTY, TENNESSEE, 1840 FEDERAL CENSUS, compiled by M. Janell McCann, 313 N. Chandler, Fort Worth, TX 76111, softbound, 50 pages, \$15 postpaid. There are 2,375 households listed in the order they were enumerated, giving the tallies for males, females, slaves, free colored persons, military pensioners, and physically impaired. A separate, full name index is included on different colored paper - a nice convenience for the user. The material is succinct and should prove very helpful to researchers of the area.-DWA

KENNARD, KING, McCUBBIN, KNIGHT AND THEIR KIN, by Alta K. Patterson, hardbound, 312 pages, \$38 postpaid. Order from Alvir Press, 24435 Lightwoods, Huffman, TX 77336. This marvelous, massive volume traces descendants of Richard Kennard, born about 1640/1650, through three generations of Nathaniel Kennards, through James Jones Kennard, George Mortimer Kennard, John Bruce Kennard to the author, Alta Kennard

Patterson Other Kennard lines from Richard involve Brummett, Haley, Harrison, King, Knight, McCubbin, Patterson, Stone, Rupe, Williams, Whitfield and many more families. Care has been taken to cite primary source material and to state unproved such parentage as not positively established. Deeds, wills, court records, land records, census support the information in this book. Photos, charts, colorful family crests, and a full name index make this a real treasure for researchers of Kennard and associated families.-DWA

THE MEEK FAMILY OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, VIRGINIA: Some Descendants of Joseph Meek, Sr. by Danny Morris Fluhart, Box 221E, Hoffman Road, Waldorf, MD 20601, hardbound, 1,055 pages (price not stated, inquire of Mr. Fluhart). The late Joseph Meek of Washington, DC, left a bequest for publication of this book. Mr. Meek and his wife, Alice Edwards Meek, collected data for forty years on Meek/Meeks families included in this book. The book begins with Joseph Meek, Sr. who died about 1810, and follows ten generations of the family. The manuscript follows the modified register system, making it easy to follow. A great deal of primary source material and family reminiscences are included. Some of the allied family names are Allison, Anderson, Barnett, Bishop, Campbell, Shausee, Cole, Copenhagen, David, Debusk, Dunn, Gose, Gray, Grubbe, Hamm, Hemphill, Hoge, Hubble, Johnson, Land, Lovell, McCall, Penland, Pyeatt, Rouse, Scott, Shinn, Snapp, Starns, Stone, Stringer, Thompson, Tilson, Widener, and many, many others.-DWA

BRANCHES OF THE FAMILY OF JAMES BLAIR: Especially the Descendants of John Washington Blair, by Ralph Young Blair. Donated by Mrs. Condray Blair Hallum, 3116 South 70th West Ave., Tulsa, OK 74145, to be placed in the AGS collection at the Central Arkansas Library System. The book begins with James Blair, born in Ireland in 1755, and especially concentrates on descendants of John Washington Blair (1827-1908) giving charts and narratives about the family members. There is a full name, annotated index.-DWA

NEWBERRY FAMILY AND IN-LAWS, by Grant Harold Collar, Jr., PO Box 1501, Little Rock, AR 72203, hardbound, 413 pages, \$25 postpaid. This book covers ten generations of the John Newberry-Joanna Swain (married 1786 in NC) family as well as other Newberry families, related and unrelated. There is a world of material here to answer most questions related to the surname Newberry. A clear explanation of the format appears in the front of the book. This monumental undertaking is very well done. Almost 6,500 people are listed in the full name index in nearly 9,000 entries (women are listed by maiden and married names). Some allied families are Allred, Bateman, Bunch, Clark, Clements, Collar, Davis, Fender, Garrison, Godfrey, Johnson, Knight, Logan, McKaskle, Robertson, Sims, Smith and others.-DWA

HISTORY OF THE SIMON MILLS FAMILY, BOOKS IV AND V, by Ralph E. Mills, 2160 Fort #4, Trenton, MI 48183, hardbound, Book IV is 522 pages, \$25 postpaid; Book V is 500 pages, \$25 postpaid. Mr. Mills had written a wonderful saga of the descendants of Simon Mills whose earliest date in America is found at Windsor, CT- 1639. Book IV chronicles the 11th generation, most of whom are living today. This looks like the ultimate successful cousin hunt! Book V is the conclusion of the series with more Mills descendants and additional information. Both books have full name indexes and many photos.-DWA

THE GENEALOGY AND HISTORY OF THE STEWART FAMILY OF HALIFAX COUNTY, VIRGINIA, CASEWELL AND PERSON COUNTIES, NORTH CAROLINA, TRIGG COUNTY, KENTUCKY, Volumes I and II, by Martha Jane Stone, 810 Cramer Avenue, Lexington, KY 40502. Both volumes are available bound together and are \$44.95 perfect bound or \$59.95 for hardcover (postpaid). The books follow the descendants of James Stewart (1718-

1773), and his children, Thomas, Elizabeth, William, Rachel, James, Agness and Stephen. Primary records, facsimiles of documents, photos and family stories enliven the Stewarts' history. Allied names are Aldridge, Blakeley, Cameron, Fuller, Goode, Hodge, Mason, Overby, Stone, Towler, Turner, Warren and more.-DWA

A GENEALOGY OF THE CROSSMAN FAMILY: Descendants of John and Robert Crossman of Taunton, Massachusetts, by Robert Owen Crossman, 908 Front Street, Conway, AR 72032. Softbound, 210 pages, \$31.50 postpaid. The book begins with John Crossman, born 1588 at Newport, RI. Eleven generations of the family with maps, charts, photos, current addresses of descendants, a bibliography and more makes this almost everything you ever wanted to know about the family, but Mr. Crossman has also published a supplement (#1) of 470 pages (write for price) with even more information that grew from his initial book. Both books have full name indexes. Mr. Crossman and his wife, Marcia Gail Swain Crossman, have co-authored A GENEALOGY OF THE SWAIN FAMILY: Descendants of Jesse Abner Swain. Softbound, 126 pages (write for price). This book includes descendants of Jesse Abner Swain who was born in 1819 in IL or NC. Photos, facsimiles of original papers, transcriptions and source notations make this an interesting book. The layout and design of the book are especially visually appealing. There is a full name index.-DWA

"Messrs. Joseph Moore, late soldier in Allen's Company of 17th Regiment of Infantry and Robert Higgins, late soldier in Capt. Philips Company of Artillery and their legal representatives are informed that on authority of papers intrusted to my charge, I have obtained patents for their bounty land, situated in Arkansas Territory. Not knowing how to address them on the subject, and knowing by laws of the Territory their lands will at a certain period be liable to be sold for taxes, I have thought proper to convey to those interested the above information."
