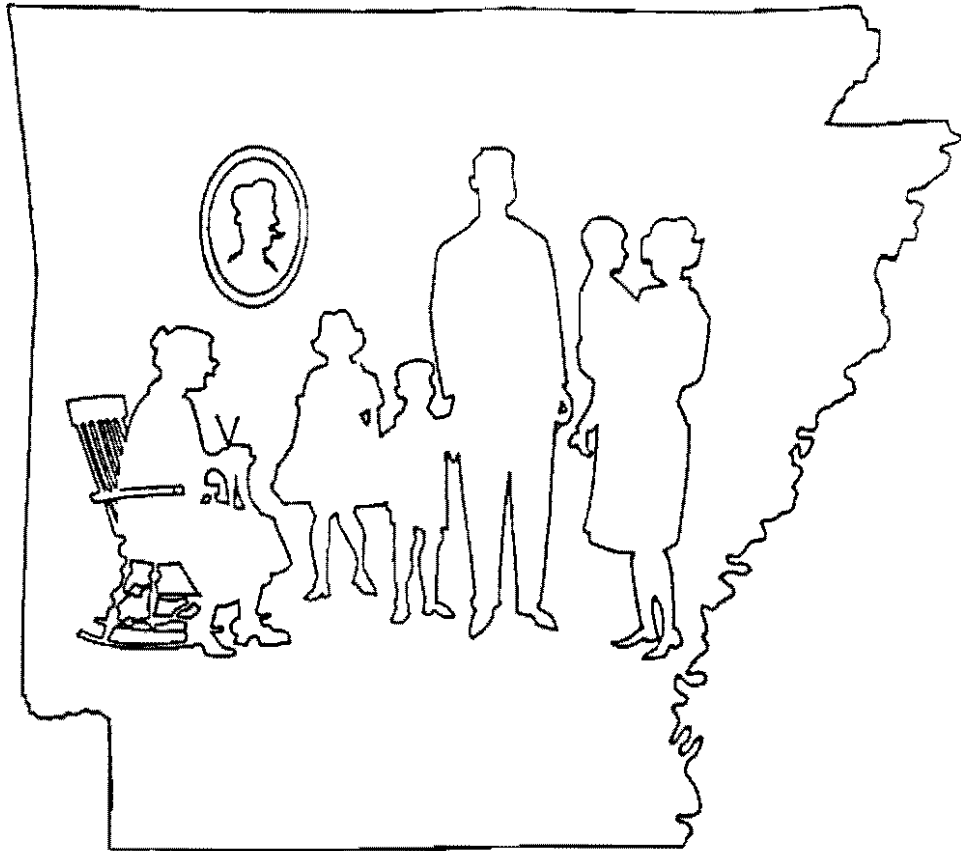

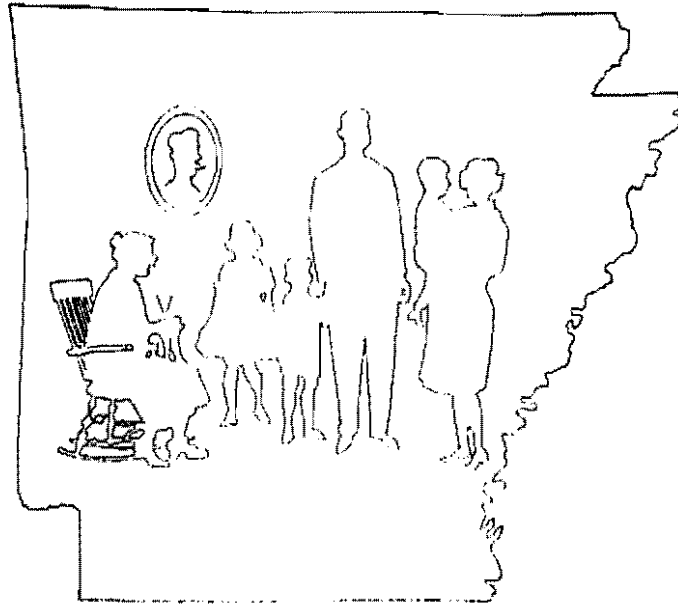

Arkansas Genealogical Society's Surname Directory is a hit! We received nearly 1,200 registration forms from all over the US. Since registration was open to non-AGS members, too, we have some 'new blood' represented. AGS has gained at least 200 new members so far from the surname directory project and we want to especially welcome our newcomers. The directory lists over 9,000 surnames of families who lived in Arkansas. In addition to the alphabetical list of surnames, we sorted the entries by county - an interesting way to look for allied lines. All the data entry was done by Ed Voyles of Conway and we sincerely appreciate his efforts. I hope you've ordered your copy so you can make new connections with folks who share your family lines. The directory is \$9.50 postpaid - an order form is included elsewhere in this issue. Our first printing was a conservative 500 copies which sold out in the first few weeks. A second printing has already been done.

The AGS Board of Directors voted to join Federation of Genealogical Societies. FGS gives all societies who join the option of sending in their membership lists so all members can receive a copy of the Forum, a quality genealogical newsletter. However, before AGS submits the membership list, we want to give you the option of having your name omitted. Important: If you do NOT want your name given to FGS, please notify AGS before 1 October. FGS guarantees the membership lists they receive will not be used for commercial purposes.

Member Mona L. Tea of Roswell, NM, wrote complimenting us for the list of current fees for birth certificates, and asked for the same information on death certificates. Here it is.

When writing for copies, provide: the name of person whose record is being requested; sex; parents names, including maiden name of mother; place (city or town, county and state); name of hospital if known; purpose for which needed; relationship to person whose record is being requested. This same information is also needed for birth records.

The following is taken from DHHS Publication No. (PHS) 87-1142, Where to Write For Vital Records, Births,Deaths, Marriages, and Divorces. The booklet was published in 1987, and prices may have changed since then. It was out of print when we inquired, but a newer issue may be available from the Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington, DC 20402. Write and ask for the price of this publication (latest price we have is \$1.50 each), if interested.

This one is Miscellaneous Texas Newspaper Abstracts, Volume IV, 234 pages plus index and contains material from The Galveston Civilian & Gazette 1839, The Galveston Daily News 1865-1867, The Clarksville Northern Standard 1869-1861, The Bastrop Advertiser 1870s and The Belton Journal 1870s and early 1880s. Within the Galveston Daily News are a large number of deaths for the yellow fever epidemic of 1867, over 1,000 death notices from Galveston, Houston, Matagorda, Corpus Christi, Victoria, and Brenham. Cost of this microfiche is \$7.00.

Affidavit

Mary Jane Carlton, being first duly sworn, on oath deposes and says:
My name is Mary Jane Carlton, I am the wife of J. E. Carlton of Pauls Valley, Garvin County, Oklahoma. I was born January 16, 1868, in Newton County, in the State of Arkansas, and moved to Avalon, Ellis County, Texas, in 1885, and moved to Indian Territory, now Oklahoma in 1896. My post office address is 603 Nth. Santa Fe Street, Pauls Valley, Garvin County, Oklahoma; my maiden name is Farmer, I am the daughter of John Barney Farmer and Sarah Levina Virginia Buchanan, my mother is the daughter of Joseph M. Buchanan, who was born April 9, 1927(sic) in Tennessee, lived in Virginia and was killed near Jasper, Newton County, Arkansas, about beginning of the Civil War; he married Thurzey Jane Dugan, in 1844, near Seven Mile Ford, Smythe County, Virginia; they had nine children -

John W. Weldon, b. 25 Dec 1842, S.C., d. 2 May 1894, Pleasant Valley, Yell Co., AR. John was shot and killed by John White, a man he had arrested for stealing his pig.

John married, 26 Oct 1865, Pulaski Co., Ark., Margaret A. Mulligan/Milegan, b. 1848, Alabama, dau. of Felix Mulligan, b ca 1820 and Bridget ___ b ca 1832. She died Jan. 1921, Pleasant Valley, Yell Co., Ark. Neither John nor Margaret could read or write so her name was spelled wrong on her marriage license. Information on this family is from census, county records, headstones and the personal records of Eva and Odell Weldon.

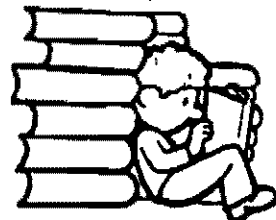

The following are reviews and/or announcements of book acquisitions for the Arkansas Genealogical Society. These books are permanently housed at the Arkansas History Commission, or in the local History and Genealogy Room of the Little Rock Public Library. The Society expresses its appreciation to the authors and contributors. In ordering copies of these books, please remember to say you saw the review in this publication!

INDEX TO ARKANSAS CONFEDERATE SOLDIERS, compiled by Desmond Walls Allen. (Volume I, A-G; Volume II, H-O; Volume III, P-Z) Each volume is \$24, or the complete set of three volumes is \$68.00 postpaid. At long last! A wonderfully useful research tool for those who do not have access to these microfilm indexes. To be able in your own home, or local library, to check this index in order to determine if your ancestor served in an Arkansas Confederate unit in the War Between the States is something many of us have longed for! This set contains nearly 80,000 references to men who served from Arkansas, transcribed from 26 rolls of microfilm. Full names, units, companies, ranks in and out, and cross references are listed. This series of three volumes contains abstracts from National Archives Microfilm Publication M376, Index to Compiled Service Records of Confederate Soldiers Who Served in Organizations from the State of Arkansas. Again we are indebted to Ms. Allen for providing ready access to this premier Arkansas resource - long needed by Arkansas researchers. These abstracts are very well done in Ms. Allen's customary competent and professional manner. - BJM

COURT OF COMMON PLEAS AND CIRCUIT COURT - HEMPSTEAD COUNTY, ARKANSAS TERRITORY 1819 - 1822 \$12 postpaid, softbound, 88 pages. Order from Hempstead County Genealogical Society, PO Box 1158, Hope, AR 71801. This is a transcript of the earliest known court record for Hempstead County, Arkansas Territory. Hempstead County, one of the original five counties of Arkansas Territory at the time of this record, encompassed all or part of the following twelve counties of present Southwest Arkansas: Columbia, Hempstead, Howard, Lafayette, Little River, Miller, Nevada, Ouachita, Pike, Polk, Sevier, and Union. Since no 1820 census for this area has ever been found, this is probably the best substitute available. Full name index of this court record included with this transcript. - BJM

PEART FAMILY GENEALOGY, Oct. 1985, PEART FAMILY - MY DAD'S SIDE, 1989, and THE CERTAIN FAMILY - MY MOTHER'S SIDE, 1989 These three books by Curtis John Peart, have been donated as gifts to our Society by Asst. Librarian Arlene Chapin Forsberg, Wenatchee, WA, who says though Curtis was born mute, he does family history extensively and is an inspiration to all the descendants of these families. Several of the articles have been extracted from the IZARD Co. Historian. One of the booklets contains an article concerning this Peart family, from Volume 16, No. 4, Oct. 1984 of the IZARD Co. CEMETERIES OF MARION COUNTY by Lester and Marian Burnes has recently been published and is available from the authors at PO Box 365, Yellville, AR 72687, for \$20 softcover or \$25 hardcover, postpaid (175 pages, surname index). Mr. and Mrs. Burnes began collecting the information in this book in the early 1960s for their own use. Since that time, some of the cemeteries have been destroyed and this book contains possibly the only records available. Descriptions of the cemeteries are included, even for those with no legible stones. Some cemeteries were moved by the Corps of Engineers when Bull Shoals Dam was built and a list of those graves is included. An account of

the War between the States' deaths of the Angel and Garrett families' men gives a sad picture of war times in Marion County. Of nine men in the two families of age to serve, only two survived the war. Unfortunately, Mrs. Burnes' printer proved a grave disappointment. He did a poor typesetting job and made some omissions and errors. Despite this, no serious researcher of Marion County families should pass up this valuable resource. - DWA

LAWRENCE COUNTY, ARKANSAS TERRITORY ESTATE SETTLEMENT BOOK: 1821 - 1832 by Marion S. Craig, M. D., 80 pages, including a full name index. This book, a gift to AGS from Dr. Craig, is a full transcription, not just an abstract, of the earliest extant Estate Settlement Book: 1821-1832 of Lawrence County, Arkansas Territory. While the book is not for sale, Dr. Craig has given copies to the Arkansas History Commission, The Family History Library in Salt Lake City, the library and museum at the old Powhatan Courthouse in Lawrence County, and to some other libraries. These very early records contained in this book, are especially welcome additions to the other excellent publications Dr. Craig has compiled for this area of our State. The book is not available for sale. - BJM

CHEROKEE BY BLOOD: Records of Eastern Cherokee Ancestry in the U. S. Court of Claims, 1906-1910, Volume 5, Applications 10171-13260, by Jerry Wright Jordan, 449 pp., index, paper, \$25.00, plus \$3.00 shipping per order. Order from Heritage Books, Inc., 1540-E Pointer Ridge Place, Suite 300, Bowie Maryland 20716. In 1904 the Eastern Cherokees won large cash settlements from the United States because of government violations of the treaties of 1835-36 and 1845. Over a million dollars was appropriated by Congress to settle the claims. The payments were to go to all living persons who had been members of the Eastern Cherokee tribe at the time of the treaty, or to their descendants, if they were deceased. Over 46,000 people filed claims. These volumes present detailed abstracts of those applications including numerous verbatim transcriptions of affidavits by applicants, their families and friends. Since most of the applicants were descendants, rather than original tribe members, and had to prove their descent, the quantity of genealogical information is staggering. Volume 5 does not appear to have as quite as many Arkansas applicants as the previous 4 volumes, nevertheless, a random check reveals there are a number of applications filed from applicants living in Arkansas; among them Barney F. Ballard of Gravette, Ark.; Mathison, Jug, and Edley Rogers, Blue Mountain and Riley, Ark. Subrina T. James and seven children of Fayetteville; Alex, Nancy and Sage White of Maysville, Ark. AR, and others. Although the applicants had to have Indian ancestry, the majority were nominally white; a significant number of blacks are also included. - BJM

THE CROUSE FAMILY OF ARKANSAS: LEST WE FORGET by J.D. Crouse, 13100 Clarion Court, Fort Washington, MD 20744 (1989). This is a work-in-progress, covering eight generations of the Crouse family. It begins with Thomas Crouse, born ca. 1816 in Virginia, who moved to Tennessee, then to Dallas County, Arkansas in the early 1850's. Very few sources are given and there is no index to this manuscript, but descendants will find much of interest. - CEB.

GENEALOGICAL GEMS OF THE WHEAT FAMILY, Some of the Descendants of the Basil Wheat Family and Allied Families Eagle and Walton: Today and Yesterday's Cousins, 1779-1983 by Ann Wheat Bryan (Benton, AR: By the author, 1984); \$25.00, plus \$5.00 p&h, from the author, 2015 Southshore, Benton, AR 72015; iv., 316 pp., indexed, comb-bound. Basil Wheat, Mrs. Bryan's ancestor, was a Revolutionary War soldier, and the book follows the family's descent from him. The book is documented and replete with reproductions of documents, pictures, and family Bible pages. A treasure for anyone connected to this family. - CEB.

GENEALOGY GEMS OF THE BRYAN FAMILIES AND SOME OF THE DESCENDANTS OF BENJAMIN BRYAN and Allied Families Faulkner and Furr (1691-1987 by Ann Wheat Bryan (Benton, AR: By the author, 1987); \$25.00 plus \$4.00 p&h, from the author (address as above); v., 220

pp., index, comb-bound. The book begins with Benjamin Bryan, Sr., born ca. 1787, in Virginia; resided Hall County, Georgia; died ca. 4 September 1854. One group of descendants of the family came to Saline County, Arkansas. As noted in the review of Mrs. Bryan's earlier book, her documentation is well-done and there are many reproductions of documents and pictures, as well as transcripts of letters and newspaper articles. Mrs. Bryan is to be commended for fulfilling what should be the goal of all genealogists: taking years of research on her family and making it accessible to all in a splendid manner. - CEB.

DESCENDANTS OF THE MAY-HOBSON-LAIN FAMILIES by Jeannette Lain Swafford and James Murry Lain (1989); hardbound, 176 pp., indexed. Mrs. Swafford's address is P.O. Box 1065, Fairfield Bay, AR 72088; Mr. Lain's address is P.O. Box 15346, Baton Rouge, LA 70895. The book utilizes a family-group-sheet format, interspersed with text, and sources are fairly well cited. The book is not for sale; the authors have admirably fulfilled their desire to "document their family and make it available for others," by donating copies to various libraries. The families originated in Pittsylvania County, Virginia, and many descendants settled in Arkansas. John May was a Revolutionary soldier. - CEB.

CONFEDERATE CEMETERY INDEX, ARSENAL ISLAND, ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS Bill D. Morgan, D. C., 5201 N. 7th Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85013, has copied this Index from Microfilm M918-001 from the National Archives and has sent AGS a copy with his compliments. He feels by sharing with the states involved, it justified the project. The Register of Confederate Soldiers and Sailors who died at Arsenal Island, Rock Island, Illinois while prisoners of war contains the names of Arkansas soldiers, including Rank, Company, Regiment, Date of Death, Number and Locality of Grave, 59 pages, listed in alphabetical order. Mr. Morgan does not indicate that he has copies for sale. - BJM

FRANKLIN COUNTY, ARKANSAS, 1870 UNITED STATES CENSUS, transcribed by Bill Hanks, and published by Margaret Harrison Hubbard, 1207 Shady Grove Road, Hot Springs, AR 71901-9510, softbound, surname index, 139 pages, \$18.00 postpaid. This is a transcription of the 1870 census and is compiled in original order. It includes township, dwelling and family members with data exactly as shown on the microfilm, showing occupations where given. Another excellent publication of early census records from an area that has not had full coverage. (BJM)
