President's Page

Thank you for your support of Arkansas Genealogical Society during the past two years while I have had the singular honor of serving as your president. I feel very proud of the accomplishments of the Society during my term and I couldn't have done the job I did without the support of each of you and especially the assistance and guidance of Bobbie Jones McLane, Margaret Harrison Hubbard and my capable vice-president, Carolyn Earle Billingsley. The members of our AGS Board of Directors have been especially helpful with encouragement and ideas.

I have some new information to share with you about AGS's previously published materials. We have no storage facilities for back issues of *The Arkansas Family Historian* or other of our publications, so we cannot hold a supply in reserve and offer them for sale. We have found a way, however, to make this valuable information available again. Microfiche! We felt most of our members were accustomed to using microfilm and microfiche in their library research. We contacted a firm in Little Rock and have made arrangements to have back issues of *The Arkansas Family Historian*, previously published series of AGS members' ancestor charts and family group sheets (published 1975 through 1983), and books AGS offers for sale microfilmed. The firm used the initial microfilm to make master microfiche jackets and they can produce diazo copies of microfiche quickly and inexpensively for us. An order form for our materials on fiche is included with this quarterly (or write AGS, PO Box 908, Hot Springs, AR 71902, send a SASE, and request a fiche order form).

John Sanders of North Little Rock, one of our AGS board members, has compiled a surname index to *The Arkansas Family Historian* for the years 1981 through 1988. If you would like to order a copy, it is listed (though not available yet on fiche) on our microfiche price list. We are especially grateful to John for his efforts in producing this index.

Edsel F. Voyles of Conway is compiling a consolidated surname index to the series of ancestor charts and family group sheets previously published by AGS. The family group sheet series contains 16 volumes of information, and the ancestor chart series contains 26 volumes. While some of the addresses of submitters of the information may be out-of-date, the material is just too valuable to overlook. Each volume in both series has a surname index, but a consolidated index to each series will facilitate their use. An announcement will appear in *The Arkansas Family Historian* when the indexes are available. (See the microfiche price list for more details about the cost of these series.)

Eddie G. Landreth of Benton, our newest AGS board member, has agreed to work on compilation for publication of the Pulaski County Marriage Project begun as a private venture by Gene Stanley of Little Rock. Gene published an initial volume, surnames A through D. He contributed his unsold volumes to AGS as well as data for part of a second volume on computer diskette. More about the project will be announced as it progresses.

The Ozark Folk Center, Mountain View, Arkansas, is holding a three day genealogical seminar December 6, 7 and 8, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Workshops begin Thursday at noon and end Saturday at 4:30 pm. There are evening sessions on Thursday and Friday. Topics include land records, LDS research, German research, military records, photography, census records, courthouse research, church records and Confederate and Union pension records. The fee for the workshop is \$25 per day. Special room rates are available at the Folk Center Lodge. Call Dr. William K. McNeil, 501/269-3851, at the Ozark Folk Center for more information about the seminar.

Additional Information for Friendship Cemetery, Saline County, Arkansas:

Yvonne Harper, 1680 Lupton Ave., San Jose, CA 95125, has written to add information to this cemetery that was published in the September, 1990, issue of The Arkansas Family Historian: "Sam" Carter should be "Slim" and his date of death was 1936, not 1938. He was a son of Allen and Martha Carter. Isaac F. Carter, SR was also Martha and Allen's son. His year of birth should be 1886.

"There is an additional marked grave in the cemetery which belongs to Isaac Carter. There are no dates on his headstone, but there is a C.S.A. cross inscribed 'CO I, 28 ALA INF'. Born in 1833, he was Allen Carter's father.

"John F. Smith was the husband of Allen and Martha's daughter, Ella Mae, who was buried in 1887 in the grave that was indicated as 'unmarked'.

"Although her stone lists her year of birth as 1860, Martha Josephine Carter, nee Inman, was probably born in 1858, as she is listed as age two on the 1860 Census for Oktibbena County, Mississippi. Wayne D. Carter, a grandson of Martha and Allen, was their son Ike's child.

"Martha's father Charles, my great, great-grandfather, came to Arkansas sometime after 1865 and settled in Saline County. Martha and Allen were the grand parents of Virgie Carter DuVall

of Tull, Arkansas, who furnished much of this information and gave me a guided tour of the cemetery during my 1987 visit."

According to the famous genealogist of the past, Leonard Andrea:

"Any gnealogist who is worth a gram of salt has to be a combination of detective, lawyer, mind-reader, scientist, historian, and have a nose similar to a bloodhound, plus many other attributes, and then a sort of 6th sense [together] with a keen intuitive mind."

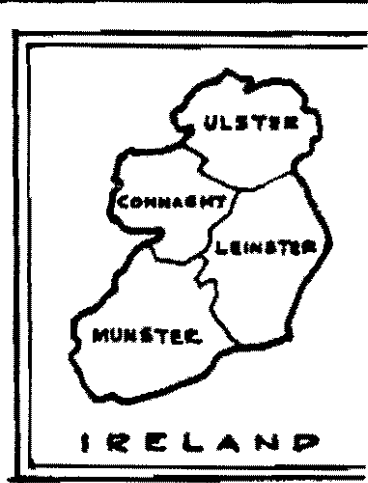

SO THAT'S WHAT HAPPENED TO THE RECORDS!

(St. Francis County)

Researchers working with St. Francis County records have often been disappointed to learn that almost no records exist before 1865 except for early tax records located at the Arkansas History Commission. Now, thanks to information supplied by Jonathan Smith of Memphis, Tennessee, the reason for this lack of records at the court house level for a county created in 1822 has been uncovered.

In an old minute book of the West Tennessee Supreme Court located in Jackson, Tennessee, Mr. Smith came across testimony in a case about the burning of the St. Francis County records in 1863. "West Tenn. Supreme Court Archives, Jackson, Tennessee Minute Book 1866-1869, pages 497-505. Silas D. Irwin, exect. of John B. Davis v W. G. Ford. Year 1869. As the Yankees neared Madison [the county seat of] St., Francis County, so this item relates, the public records were taken and placed in a small frame building out in the woods. This was done to protect the records. Ironically, the building caught fire or was purposely burned and all but one volume was burned." This book was Deed Book "K", dating from 1860. David C. Cross, for whom Cross County, Arkansas, was named, offered the testimony in this case.

LIBERTY CHURCH

Dallas County

The church at Liberty was constituted on Saturday, October 9, 1852, into the Primitive Faith and Order of the South Arkansas Association by Granville Gipson and Norman F. Goodrich, ordained ministers of the Association.

Constituted With 4 Members

Lashley Wood, Stephen Benson, Elizabeth Wood and Elinda Goodrich, all by letters. Eld. Norman W. Goodrich joined that day by letter. Lashley Wood and Stephen Benson were ordained deacons of the Primitive faith and order and were appointed as deacons for Liberty Church. Stephen Benson was chosen as Church Clerk. Elder Norman F. Goodrich was chosen as pastor.

The meeting day was Saturday before the Second Sunday in each month.

On November 13, 1852, the Church voted to have sacramental meetings twice a year, April and September.

Liberty Church burned February 12, 1910.

On Saturday before the second Sunday in August 1911, Liberty Church met in conference and decided to rebuild the old Liberty Church House on the same old grounds and agreed that the house may be used for all township business and for the cemetery, and further agreed to use the timber on [the] land for building purposes. These privileges are not to conflict with the regular meeting days on the first Sunday and Saturday before, of each month. This done and signed by order of Liberty Church.

FIRST DOCTOR IN JEFFERSON COUNTY

Dr. Wood Tucker

Member Ellis O. Moore submitted the following notes that were uncovered by his wife, Peggy Sorrells Moore concerning her Arkansas family - Sorrells, Fletcher and Tucker in Jefferson County. The "JHS" who wrote the note at the top of the first page was her father, John Harvey Sorrells, born 31 March 1896 in Pine Bluff, died 25 February 1948 in New York City. At his death he was Executive Editor of the Scripps-Howard Newspapers, and President of the Memphis Publishing (The Commercial Appeal and Press-Scimitar, the latter now extinct, and WMC-TV and WMC radio). John Harvey Sorrells is buried in Graceland Cemetery, Pine Bluff, as is his wife, the former Ruth Arnett, born 16 July 1898, Pine Bluff, died 20 October 1956, Memphis.

[Notes at the top of the page] Some notes dictated by Mrs. Ruth (Fletcher) Foss concerning her grandfather, Dr. Wood Tucker (my great-grandfather) and her father, Reid Fletcher, and her mother, Eliza Fletcher (My grandfather and grandmother)--JHS, December 21, 1945.

Dictated by Mrs. Foss (my Aunt) In Pine Bluff, Arkansas, December 12, 1945

During the middle 1800's, steady streams of settlers flowed toward Arkansas from all directions. They endowed her with their ideas, their labors, and a great diversity of hereditary potential. The first doctor in Pine Bluff (Jefferson County) was a Virginian, Dr. Wood Tucker. Tucker Lake where he built his Arkansas home is named for him. In 1850 he was sixty-four years old, and his daughter, Eliza, born in Arkansas, was thirteen. His son, S. H. Tucker, was Little Rock's first banker.

Dr. Tucker's home was the scene of many big "fish fries" and deer barbeques, which characterized social events of that day. On the lake was a big pavilion for dancing.

At nearby Brump's Bayou, Eliza Tucker received the meager formal education offered at a frontier school.

When old Judge Sorrells (grandfather of John and Walter and Mary and Emma Sorrells) held court in Pine Bluff, he habitually rode out to stay with the Tuckers.

In the 1860's, Pine Bluff society received the young Reid Fletcher, member of a prominent Nashville, Tennessee family. Reid's father, Thomas Fletcher, was a prominent lawyer and writer. His portrait is in evidence in the gallery in Nashville.

Perhaps at one of the entertainments given by her father, Eliza Tucker met Reid Fletcher. She was a beautiful girl with lively brown eyes and chestnut hair. Eliza was young, and according to the old Doctor Reid, was "too gay" for her. Reid's family on the other hand were sticklers for education and Eliza's spelling was atrocious.

Reid declared, however, that "he would marry her if he had to walk a crooked rail over hell." Eliza ran away and the ceremony was performed at the home of Col. M. L. Bell (Col. Bell's wife was a Miss Roane, and she was related to the Tuckers?) No best friend of Eliza.

The Fletchers soon fell in love with Eliza. When the young couple appeared at the Opera in Nashville, all the glasses in the house were leveled on Eliza, in tribute to her beauty. Intelligent companionship assiduously cultivated during her travels stimulated an active mind and enhanced her charms. Her interest extended to newspapers when Reid, upon their return to Pine Bluff, started the first newspaper there. Later, he started another paper, The Graphic.

Thomas Fletcher and his brother moved to this state and built the most beautiful home on the Arkansas River, near Red Fork. He became Governor of Arkansas and presided over the Senate for 12 years. The indelible impression of his ideas remain a part of the state's early history. To distinguish him from another judge of the same name in Little Rock, he was called Judge Thomas Fletcher of Lincoln. After the flood which washed his home and plantation into the River, it is said of this man that he was as composed and smiled as happily as when he could write a check for thousands.

During the Civil War, Reid Fletcher was Captain in the 18th Arkansas Regiment. After he returned home, he held many offices of trust and was on numerous occasions named as special judge. He also wrote articles for The Gazette, and on the morning that Eliza presented him with their third set of twins, he began his article thus:

"They say that a child in the house is a spring of joy, but my spring is overflowing this morning. I have another set."

The first set were two girls, then came two boys, and this set were a boy and a girl. They named the girl Iva, and she was the mother of John, Walter, and Mary and Emma Sorrells.

Thomas Fletcher came to visit his brother and gave his nieces Juliette and Ruth each a diamond ring. He was running against Mr. Frolic for the position of Secretary of State. A week later, before the issue could be decided, Judge Thomas Fletcher died of pneumonia.

Reid contracted consumption and was ill for ten years. During this time, the family finances became so depleted that Ruth Fletcher (Mrs. Foss) began to teach school. Women seldom worked in those days, and the daughter was distressed at the thought that she might bring criticism upon her father. He was very proud of her, however, and told her that not many little girls of fifteen could teach school. Will Roan's wife had been forced to take a job clerking. When complimented on her courage for defying convention of her day, she was wont to reply, "I don't think I deserve any credit for not starving to death." Ruth was encouraged by her example and her spirited reply.

Iva received much of her education from her older sister. Once when the younger girl was recovering from an attack of swamp fever, Ruth insisted on her returning to school before she was well enough. "Ruth, your ambition to educate these children will be the death of them yet," her mother told her.

Eliza Tucker Fletcher was regarded by her children as a truly great and intelligent woman. When she died, the floor around her bed was littered with newspapers she had recently read.

Throughout a long life, Ruth Fletcher Foss knew adversity and great tragedy. Her spirit remained valiant and her pride of race undimmed. At eighty two, her courage is evident and her manner that of a great lady. Though she has no children of her own, Iva's boys have justified her belief in the inherent greatness of her people.

Floyd and Fee and Whitfield Harris - Benjamin Franklin Fee, son of Henderson Fee and wife Margaret "Peggy" Moyers/Myers Fee. I don't know about Whitfield Harris. Could he have been a descendant of John and Lucy Harris who were in among others Lee Co., VA, and Harlan Co. KY? Jack Noe's mother's mother was Mourning Harris, 1780-1873, wife of Alexander Dunlap and (2) David Noe, great uncle of Jack's.

Judge Fee - Henderson Fee, son of David Fee and Lucy Noe, b. 1791, VA, probably Lee Co., dau. of John and Charlotte Noe, who also were the parents of Charles Noe above.

Elbert Noe - William Elbert Noe, son of Andrew Jackson Noe and second wife, Emeline Patterson.

McVey who was rustling around may have been Abraham McVey, who married Sabine "Bine" Noe, dau. of Andrew Jackson Noe and his first wife, Jane Hathaway Moyers/Myers.

Grandma Noe - was Emeline Patterson Noe, wife of Jack Noe.

Who were Jane and Duch?

Clint Butler married Amanda Virginia Noe, b. 1866, dau. of Jack and Emeline Noe.

Jack Noe's promising son - William Elbert Noe, married Mary Lefevers.

David Jackson, Sr., b. ca. 1800, NC, d. ca 1861, m. 1?, m. 2 Penina S. Brown, both born in N. Carolina. David died in the early part of Civil War in Union prison camp of smallpox, in Greene Co., MO. In Lincoln Co., TN, census in 1830, paid taxes in Greene Co., MO, in 1833, in Taney Co., MO, census in 1840, 1850 and 1860. (I do not know if he ever lived in Arkansas. Have no documented proof) His second wife was Penina S. Brown; I do not know the name of his first wife. George W. Jackson was her son. Penina S. Brown was born 23 August 1807, North Carolina, d. in 1902 in Oakland, Arkansas, and is buried there, as is a granddaughter, Naomi Jackson, daughter of her youngest child, David Jackson. 10 children were born to David Jackson, Sr.:

1. George Washington Jackson, by his first wife, m. Mary Cook Brown; 3 children by Brown, none by Jackson.

2. Nancy Ann m. John Jackson Haggard, lived Taney Co., MO and Marion Co., Ark.;
3. John J. killed in Civil War
4. Sarah Jackson, crippled, never married. Died of cancer of the breast.
5. William T. died in Civil War (some of my family said of smallpox in Union prison camp with his father; I have no proof either way);

Of these children George W. and Nancy Ann Jackson were born in Lincoln Co., Tenn.; all the rest were born in Taney Co., MO. David married Emily Alice Noe in 1872 in Marion Co., Ark. In 1901 David Jackson and his family moved to Coweta, Oklahoma, where Emily's sisters Bine (Sabina) and husband Abraham McVey, and Sarah Jane, wife of Richard T. Tatum lived. These 2 families had formerly lived in Marion Co.

Thomas S. Noe, resident of Marion Co., had a pool hall in Coweta. Thomas was a brother of Emily, Sabina and Sarah. His wife and children continued to live in Marion Co. In 1907 my family of Jacksons moved to Bartlett, Bell and Williamson Cos., Texas, where David and Emily lived the rest of their lives.

Andrew Jackson Noe, b. 19 July 1823, Lee Co., VA, firstborn of Charles and Jane (Dunlap) Noe, died April 1899 Yellville, Ark. He m. 1850 June Hathaway Moyers/Myers, probably in Breathitt Co., KY (Hathaway is a given name. Why? My guess is that it was from a novel written during that era and the title and heroine was "Jane Hathaway"). The 15th of March 1851 the A. J. Noe's, John D. Noe's, Henderson's, Fee's and widow, Margaret (Phipps) Moyers/Myers with son Strother Moyers/Myers, arrived in Marion Co. CONFEDERATE SOLDIERS' GRAVE MARKERS ERECTED AT DUCK HILL

Individual markers for the 29 Confederate soldiers killed in a train wreck on Sunday, Oct. 19, 1862, have been erected at Duck Hill and will be dedicated Sunday, Sept. 8.

Names of 27 of the 29 men have been discovered through research that included many different types of records available to researchers Rogers Hansen, Norman Ezell and Tim Burgess, according to John E. Johnston of Jackson.

Johnston is a member of the Stanford's Mississippi Battery, an organization devoted to preservation of historic records and the reenactment of Civil War battles.

Recently, as announced here, the re-enactment group had secured individual monuments from the government to mark the graves of the train wreck victims. They spent a day at Duck Hill erecting the markers in the cemetery near the railroad tracks. It was in this plot--as old-timers have recalled and passed the word along--that a mass grave was dug for the soldiers on that fateful day in '62 when they were killed. They were on a train that had left Coffeerville a bit late from the schedule, headed south, and at about the same time another train left Canton, headed north. There was no warning that the two trains were on the same track until they met head on.

Wooden markers were placed beside the large grave, but these have been gone for a long time. No record could be found that listed the names of the men killed there, so state and local records had to be found that would tell of a man "killed in a train wreck" on that date.

It would be of great interest to Civil War buffs if they knew more about the compliment of men on that southbound train because the dead represent a number of different units from several states. It is not as if one regiment had been on board; it was a combination of men from a variety of units.

Not only that, but there were cavalymen and infantrymen included.

There were six men from Missouri, two from Tennessee, 12 from Arkansas (but most from different units), one from Louisiana, three from Texas, two from Mississippi and one whose name has been learned, but not his unit. Two others, still unknown, were also buried there. Names and units of the men for whom the new markers are ready for dedication include:

In addition to these, and the two other unknowns, the researchers found the name of Thomas W. Youngblood listed as killed in the wreck. Other records, however, indicate that he was in Camp Chase, Ohio, as a prisoner of war from Co. G. Mississippi Infantry, in 1864.


The Sept. 8 dedication of the new marker is open to the public. The city of Duck Hill has cleared the plot and dedicated it as the Civil War cemetery.

This brief history of the Crouse Family of Dallas County, Arkansas, begins with Thomas Crouse, my great, great grandfather. The only information I have about Thomas is the 1860 U.S. Census, and that is not much, and to the dismay of all of us, I have nothing before him.

According to the census of 1860, the age of Thomas Crouse was listed as 44, and that he was born in Virginia. Assuming the census was actually taken in 1860, Thomas would have been born in 1816.

Thomas Crouse and his wife "Jane" had nine children, the first six of whom were born in Tennessee and the other three in Arkansas. I have no records other than the one census but it appears that after at least ten years living in Tennessee, Thomas moved his family to Dallas County, Arkansas. Probably sometime during the period of 1850-53. After 1860, this family, with the exception of his son Joseph, seems to have vanished. I have not found a trace since.

The remainder of this history is about ninety eight percent complete.

We who care will always be haunted by the obscurity of our lineage. There is so much that we know so little about. Perhaps we could reason that those before us were insensitive to the preservation of the lineage history. But let us not forget that these people were pioneers and that their major concern was not where they had been nor who they were, but where they were going and how they would get there.

"Our days pass like the shadow of a cloud and we sometimes leave behind us, little sign of remembrance".

These books are permanently housed at the Arkansas History Commission, or in the local History and Genealogy Room of the Little Rock Public Library. The Society expresses its appreciation to the authors and contributors. In ordering copies of these books, please remember to say you saw the review in this publication!

PHILLIPS COUNTY, ARKANSAS, 1870 FEDERAL POPULATION CENSUS, Abstracted by Rose White, PO Box 580, Marvell, AR 72366, Typed by Flora Turner, PO Box 311, Brinkley, AR 72021, and may be ordered from either address. Velo-bound, surname index, 101 pages, \$12.00, plus \$2.00 postage. This transcription of the 1870 census is compiled in its original order, listing the dwelling number, family number, names, age, sex, color, birth month (for babies born within the past year), occupation, value of real estate, value of personal property, and birthplace. Unfortunately, this is not a complete transcription, as only whites were copied from this census for this book. It is important, however, coming just after the Civil War, and showing the many families left without husbands, fathers, sons and brothers. - BJM

HIGHLAND CEMETERY and Four Abandoned Cemeteries in Ozark, Arkansas by Sue Clark and Virginia McPhail. Soft-cover, indexed, 182 pages, \$18.00, this book is the first in a series of Franklin County Cemetery Records. Much of the known information about the cemetery was recorded by Mrs. T. Moore in her diary, starting with 1874 and kept until her death in 1923, then by her daughter until 1945. Another source came from the Greer Funeral Home Records, therefore there are a number of burials in Highland which are listed here, for which there are no tombstones. Copies may be ordered from Sue Clark, HC 65, Box 700, Natural Dam, AR 72948. - BJM

THE DESCENDANTS OF CLAIBORNE B. MAY including a compendium of other May Families, compiled by Imogene May Boswell, Reba Kirksey Cooper and Donna May Lonon. Smyth sewn, hardbound, fully indexed, 661 pages. There are 227 pictures and documents, \$45.00 postpaid. Order from Imogene Boswell, 2000 Spring Run Drive, Carrollton, TX 75006. Claiborne B. May was born in SC c1798 and moved to Alabama c1820. He lived in St. Clair, Talladega, Coosa Cos. and died in Greene Co. in 1860-65. Ten children by his 1st marriage to Jane M. "Jincy" Buzbee, and two children by his 2nd wife Catherine, 10 sons and 2 daughters. This book traces four of these lines through about 1870, two of these lines through about 1930, and six to the present day. The Index for these families contains more than 4500 names. Anyone researching the May and allied families in Clark and surrounding counties will find a treasure trove of material in this well researched book. Included are 70 pages of other May families of the South, which are not known to be related to this particular May family. A separate index following this chapter has more than 2500 names. The book is well documented and replete with reproductions of documents, pictures and family

Bible pages. It represents years of careful research, intelligent honest analysis and a generous sharing of the results with other searchers. - BJM

MEYER'S DIRECTORY OF GENEALOGICAL SOCIETIES IN THE U.S.A. AND CANADA. (1990) edited by Mary Keysor Meyer, 5179 Derry Road, Mt. Airy, MD 21771. This is the eighth edition of Meyer's directory, containing not only county and state societies, but also ethnic, geographic, religious, professional interest and surname organizations. A check of this book is a good way to discover groups in your areas of interest. - CEB.

RECORDS OF THE FAMILIES OF BROTHERS, SWAN, BONAR/DEEVES, BEARDSLEY. (1990) compiled by William P. Brothers, Old Nonpareil Press, 430 Maple Way, Woodside, CA 94062. A professional looking, perfect-bound book; uses photographs, charts, and original documents very effectively, but there is no compiled index, although a descendency chart at the beginning serves as an index of sorts. Many of those mentioned were early Arkansas settlers. - CEB.

FAMILY SCRAPBOOK. (1990) compiled by Evelyn Nance Dyles, 309 Maple Street, Truth or Consequences, NM 87901; hardbound, 437 pp., \$45.00 postpaid. The title is very descriptive of the book: it's an interesting melange of family history, photographs, and documents on a couple of dozen family lines, but it has no index. Some of the families are: Anderson, Arnold, Austin, Baisdon, DeFee, French, Hay, McFarland, Milam, Nance, Dyles, Rinkle, Sanford, Waddy, and Wann. - CEB.

CEMETERIES OF MONROE COUNTY, ARKANSAS. (1989) compiled by Loyd L. and Flora M. Turner, P.O. Box 311, Brinkley, AR 72021; phone 501-734-2465; Velo-bound, 237 pages, surname index, \$27.50 postpaid. Listings for each cemetery are alphabetical, rather than in order of the position of the plots. Directions to each cemetery are given. The authors, members of Tri-County Genealogical Society, are presently working on a compilation of the cemeteries of Phillips County, Arkansas. - CEB.

MASTER INDEX: AGENT FUNERAL RECORDS, BOOKS 1-14. (1989) compiled by Wilma Jean Hoyle; order from Frontier Researchers, P.O. Box 2123, Fort Smith, AR 72902; softbound, 60 pp.; no price given. This is an index to the records of the Agent Funeral Home of Sallisaw, OK, which has been in existence since 1938. The alphabetical listings give full name of deceased and the volume and page number of the original record. - CEB.

VETERANS DISCHARGE PAPERS. (1990) published by Greene County (Arkansas) Historical and Genealogical Society, 901 W. Kingshighway, Suite B, Paragould, AR 72450; comb-bound, 111 pp., \$14.00 postpaid. This book contains extractions of military discharges, covering WWI, WWII, the Civil War, and others, which are recorded at the Greene County Court House in Paragould, AR. Each contains information such as name, rank, service no., marital status, enlistment date, discharge date, and microfilm page number, and may include information such as area of service, battles, medals or awards, and physical descriptions. No index is necessary, since the entries are in alphabetical order. A quick perusal of the book indicates the majority of entries are from WWI, with very few Civil War entries. - CEB.

REGISTER OF CONFEDERATE SOLDIERS AND SAILORS WHO DIED AT ARSENAL ISLAND, ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS WHILE PRISONERS OF WAR: COMPILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER FOR MARKING GRAVES OF CONFEDERATE DEAD, WAR DEPARTMENT, 1912 (1990) by Billy D. Morgan, 5201 N. 7th Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85013; 59 pages. The compiler copied these records from the National Archives Microfilm #M918-0001, and has placed copies of his transcription in various Southern repositories. The entries are alphabetical. Additional information given includes: rank, company, regiment, date of death, and number and locality of grave. The soldiers are from all over the South, including Arkansas. - CEB.

LAWRENCE COUNTY, ARKANSAS: DEED BOOK 'B', 1817-1825 (1990) abstracted by Marion Stark Craig, M.D. This book is not for sale, but has been placed by its author in various libraries and depositories for the benefit of all researchers. Deed records often prove family relationships when other sources fail; this excellent abstraction is a valuable tool for early Lawrence County researchers. (Note that in this time period, Lawrence County covered most of north Arkansas.) There is a full-name and -place index. - CEB.

LAWRENCE COUNTY, ARKANSAS: CIRCUIT COURT 1818-1830 AND COURT OF COMMON PLEAS 1821, (1990) transcribed by Marion Stark Craig, M.D. This book, like the one above, is not for sale. There is a full-name and -place index. - CEB.

FAULKNER COUNTY, ARKANSAS CENSUS OF CEMETERIES AS OF DECEMBER 31, 1097. Faulkner County Historical Society, PO Box 731, Conway, AR 72032 has published this 912 page hardbound book. Price is \$55.00 plus \$3.50 for shipping. The census includes 110 active, inactive and abandoned cemeteries in Faulkner County and 10 cemeteries in adjoining counties. Some 24,500 names are listed. The book is arranged by cemetery with names in alpha order within each cemetery's listing. Though contrary to the "best" method for recording cemetery data, it was the only practical method for a book of this scope. A full name index is keyed not to page numbers, but to cemetery numbers. Each cemetery listing gives the name (and alternate names) of the cemetery, the legal description, its status (active, inactive or abandoned), driving directions, history or notes about the cemetery, and the ate and names of the people who inventoried the cemetery. Information included about burials includes full name, birth and death dates, and additional information when available. Maps, photos and line drawings enhance the book. This massive undertaking is a wonderful resource for Faulkner County researchers. - DWA

JOHNSON COUNTY, ARKANSAS MARRIAGES 1890 - 1913, transcribed by Imogene McConnell, indexed and published by Bobbie Jones McLane (Arkansas Ancestors), 89 pages, soft-bound, grooms names arranged alphabetically with a full name bride index. \$15.00 postpaid. Copies may be ordered from Arkansas Ancestors, 222 McMahan Drive, Hot Springs, AR 71913. Mrs. McConnell, a resident of Gresham, OR, but native of Johnson County, has transcribed these marriages included in Books R, S, and T, dating from 1890 to 1913. These continue the marriage records in Books N, P., P, and Q, dating from 1850-1890, published in 1988 by the Johnson County Historical Society. Names have been transcribed as they were recorded, though obviously many errors in spelling occurred. In attempting to decipher the names, Mrs. McConnel cross checked census, cemetery inscriptions, tax lists and Lillian Mickel's History of Johnson County. The book is a welcome addition to the growing list of publications on Johnson County. - DWA
