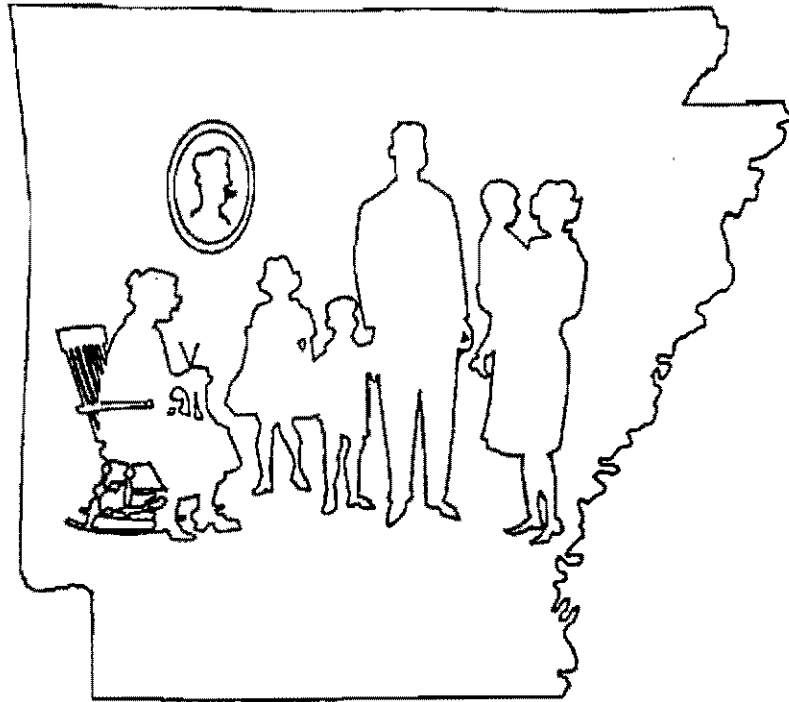

The sources from which the material was obtained, specific statements of facts, or statistical information MUST be documented; that is, the specific, detailed source description must be listed either within the body of the text or as notes. Previous

publication of material in any form must be brought to the attention of AGS. AGS encourages submissions on IBM compatible computer disks in Word for Windows or ASCII format, accompanied by a hard copy of the material.

Something new is being offered! A *Family History Writing Contest* is being sponsored by AGS to promote genealogical research in Arkansas through awarding quality family history articles. The prizes are named in honor of former AGS board members who have served the genealogical community with distinction. The awards this year are in honor of Desmond Walls Allen and in memory of Dr. Marion S. Craig and Mrs. Johnita Holmes Glover. Details are in the article in this quarterly.

At the fall meeting the AGS board voted \$5000 to be spent to purchase additional rolls of the Lyman Draper Collection for

the Arkansas History Commission. AHC has had a part of the collection for many years and AGS hopes to finally complete the collection with this purchase and an additional one next year. What is the Draper collection, you ask? It is a massive manuscript collection that was amassed by Lyman C. Draper over a nearly 60 period. It contains notes from interviews and correspondence on life on the western frontier prior to 1830. The original manuscripts are owned by the State Historical Society of Wisconsin.

Lyman C. Draper, born in Lockport, New York, in 1815, grew up hearing stories of the experiences of his grandfather in the Revolutionary War and stories his father told about being captured by the British during the War of 1812. This fueled a lifelong interest in American History. After a brief sojourn at college, where his only interest was American history, he left about 1836 and began writing letters to Kentucky pioneers collecting their stories. Thus began the Draper Collection. For several years he spoke at colleges and wrote articles on American historical and archeological topics. Among the occupations he followed to earn his living was editing the *Spirit of the Times* (Pontotoc, Mississippi), working as a land agent and speculator in Mississippi, and as a clerk in the Erie Canal office in Buffalo, New York. Throughout his life he was constantly gathering notes and reading American history for a book he intended to write. In 1843, Peter Remsen, who was married to Draper's cousin, was so impressed by Draper's vision that he agreed to fund his historical research and travel. For nine years Draper took advantage of this remarkable opportunity and made trips through the southeastern and middle states, filling thousands of notebooks with interview

notes and copies of archival records and newspaper articles. When Remsen died, Draper moved to Wisconsin, where in 1854, he was appointed corresponding secretary of the State Historical Society of Wisconsin. It was 1857 before he could again find time to do personal research. For the next thirty-four years, he made major trips for interviews and carried on correspondence on Daniel Boone, George Rogers Clark, and others. In 1881, his only book was published, *King's Mountain and Its Heroes*. He retired from the Historical Society in 1886 and was still engaged in correspondence about Clark when he died on August 26, 1891.

The areas covered in the Draper collection include the trans-Allegheny West which includes the western areas of the Carolinas and Virginia, portions of Georgia and Alabama, the entire Ohio River Valley, and part of the upper Mississippi Valley from the period of the frontier conflicts in the 1740's and 1750's to the American Revolution and the War of 1812. There are nearly 500 volumes of records. Not only does the collection include the notes made by Draper, but also dozens of letters and questionnaires sent and received by him. The Calendars to the Draper Manuscript Collection are indexed and give a brief description of the material covered in each volume.

We hope you will check the calendars and the indexes and find information on your ancestors and their neighbors!

Meet Your New Board Members

Tracey Carrington Converse was raised in Hot Springs and graduated from Lakeside High School. She attended Henderson State University and majored in history at the University of Texas. She is a former award winning radio personality from Little Rock. For several years, she was the youngest female host of a political talk show in the country.

Her interest in genealogy was sparked by her grandmother's old stories of growing up in Dallas County. She has been actively researching her families for about 15 years. Her Mhoon line were early settlers in Northwest Arkansas, arriving in 1836.

Tracey is a professional genealogical researcher and very active on the Internet. She owns several genealogical mailing lists including GenTips. She also distributes an online genealogy newsletter each month and offers genealogy forms for download free on her website. In addition to serving on the Board of Directors of Arkansas Genealogical Society, Tracey is an active volunteer at the Arkansas History Commission and Archives.

She and her husband, Brian, are the proud parents of two-year-old Andrew, and they live in North Little Rock.

Arliss D. Ray, a native of Hot Springs and a 1947 honor graduate of Hot Springs High School, attended Yale University through a Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps scholarship. He graduated in 1951 with a degree in Civil

Engineering. As a commissioned officer on the USS DeHaven (DD727), he completed two tours of sea duty in Korean waters and then became an instructor in Marine Engineering at the US Naval Academy in Annapolis. After receiving an MS degree from Oregon State University and the Ph.D. degree from the University of California, Berkeley, he was Assistant Professor at Vanderbilt University, then Professor at the University of Missouri, Columbia, in the field of Water Resources and Environmental Engineering.

In 1972, Ray left the academic world and became a Vice President with Woodward Clyde Consultants. In 1975, he co-founded an environmental consulting company in Houston, Texas, and served as an executive officer until retirement in 1992. He returned to Hot Springs in 1994 and joined the Melting Pot Genealogical Society the following year serving as Volunteer Librarian and on *ad hoc* assignments such as audits, inventories and telephone committee. During 1998 he has been Vice President with associated responsibilities as Program Chairman, and a member of the Executive Board.

He and his wife, who died in 1992, have five grown children, currently spread from coast to coast, and twelve growing grandchildren.

Jann Woodard is a native Bradley Countian, seven generations removed from her first ancestor's arrival to the area. She attended Baptist Hospital RN

School in Little Rock and has been employed since 1972 with Dr. Frank Gibson Thibault, OB-GYN, in Benton, where she has resided since 1964.

Mrs. Woodard has been a member of the Bradley County Genealogical Society since the inception, and is also an evaluator for the project, "Bayou Bartholomew History Project Oral History Phase," being compiled by Rebecca DeArmond Huskey. Mrs. Woodard is currently enrolled at UALR taking courses in history and creative writing.

She is the author of six books relating to her home county: *The O'Neal Family; Bradley County Civil War Soldiers; Bradley County Physicians; Ebenezer Cemetery, the First 140 Years; Warren Newsbriefs Extracted From The Arkansas Gazette 1841-1900; and Bradley County Obituaries Extracted From the Arkansas Methodist Newspaper 1884-1930.*

Current projects include: "Warren Newsbriefs, Vol. 2, 1900-1930"; "Drew County Newsbriefs"; and "Bradley County WW I Draft Registrations."

She is married to Benjamin Lathan Woodard, also a native of Bradley County, and they have two daughters, Julie Marie Partridge and Lucy Elizabeth Hyatt, both of Benton.

Anne Wilkerson Morris has been researching her family since 1956. In 1975-76 she participated in two genealogy courses taught by Mrs. John Fowlkes of Caruthersville, MO, at the newly opened Mississippi County Community College. She is a member of the Woodruff County Historical Society and has written for and served as co-editor of *Rivers and Roads and Points In*

Between, the publication of that organization. She has indexed *Rivers and Roads* from its' first issue in 1973 and it is to be published by Desmond Walls Allen.

Anne is a member of the Giles County, TN, Historical Society, the Natchez Trace Historical Society in Alabama, the Gen. T. J. Churchill Chapter of the UDC, and the North Pulaski Civil War Round Table, having edited the newsletter for that group for four years.

New AGS Services

A very effective means of communicating with large numbers of people with only one message is to arrange what is called a "Mailing List" on the Internet. This is an automatic mailer which receives a message from any one "subscriber" (though the service is free) and mails it to every "subscriber" to that list. This is a very valuable part of <www.rootsweb.com>. Replies to these messages can then be directed to the mailing list, if everyone should be involved with that message, or the reply can be directed privately to the one person who posted the original message.

To understand how a mailing list works and can help so many researchers, it may help to visualize a Bulletin Board. I can put a tack through a message on a bulletin board, and that message is

"posted" for all who come by to see. Anyone who sees the message can respond to it by posting a message of his/her own - or by responding privately to the person who posted the original message. That is an excellent description of a mailing list.

At the last meeting of the Board of Directors of the Arkansas Genealogical Society, three or four of us decided privately that we ought to put up a mailing list named AGS-L, the 'L' standing for 'list.' We said, "Who knows? We might have a hundred subscribers, or a few more. That will help us to exchange a large volume of information rapidly."

One of our most expert keyboarders put the list up that very afternoon, and it was accepted by <rootsweb> early in the evening. By morning we had 57 subscribers, two days later, there were 200, and we are now over 800! It is a safe statement that we have furnished information to, or helped scores of people to find information, in our first month of existence. The figure likely is in the hundreds. The people helped have been in Canada, Britain, Australia, New Zealand and the United States. I have personally worked 85-89 messages daily for three weeks. For my health's sake, I am having to cut back, but others are picking up, and so far as I know, not a single message has gone unanswered or unacknowledged.

If you have e-mail and want to participate, here's how - Address an e-mail message to <AGS-L-REQUEST@rootsweb.com>. In the body

of the message, type only the word, subscribe. Just, subscribe -that's it, no quote marks, no punctuation, no anything. If you decide later, "I want loose from this thing," use the same address, but this time type only unsubscribe. There is NO cost. You will never get a bill. You don't ever have to comment unless you want to. Any time you get the urge to communicate and want the whole world to know it, address your message to <Ags-l@rootsweb.com>, type whatever you want to say, and send it as you would any other e-mail message. About 800 of us will get your message. Several of us may shower you with answers, advice, or "what?s." A "what?" is a gentle suggestion that you furnish a little more information or clear up your message and try again. We get a lot of requests for "any information at all on the Enny Blacklist family." No one can coherently answer a message like that. Give a NAME, a DATE of an EVENT, and a PLACE. Naturally, since this is an Arkansas list, we expect at least one of the places to be Arkansas. It still helps so much if you could choose a county, or a region. We have 78 county names. Three of them don't exist any more, but that still leaves 75! Please try to choose one. An EVENT can be birth, marriage, death, taxes paid, stock mark or brand registered, murdered, imprisoned, was elected or appointed to office, appeared in census -97 you get the idea.

Subscribe now and let's keep that information flowing. And don't forget that there is a nationwide databank called <www.usgenweb.org>. There are a lot of good people there, too.

United States Land Office

Little Rock, Ark.

Nov. 10, 1898

Sir:

Your homestead entry No. 19611, Sec. 21, T 10 W, R 13 W, was made Oct. 26, 1883 and the five years during which residence and cultivation were required by law expired Oct. 26, 1898.

The law provides that patent shall issue upon the presentation of proper proof of residence and cultivation within THREE years after the expiration of the five years referred to, see act of Congress, approved July 26, 1884 (28 Stat., 123).

If this final proof is not presented within the time prescribed, this Office shall be warranted in treating the entry as voluntarily abandoned on your part.

Arkansas Genealogical Society, Inc. (AGS) is sponsoring a writing competition to promote genealogical research in Arkansas and encourage quality family history writing. The prizes given will recognize AGS members who have served the genealogical community with distinction. The awards are in honor of Desmond Walls Allen, and in memory of Dr. Marion S. Craig, and Mrs. Johnita Holmes Glover.

CONTEST

Who The AGS Family History Writing (AGS-FHW) Contest is open to all members of AGS. (Exception: Current members of the AGS-FHW Awards Committee are excluded). Also, students who are not members of AGS may enter with proof of high school or college enrollment of at least nine (9) semester hours.

What The AGS-FHW Contest is limited to family history articles with an Arkansas connection. They must be 2,000 words or less and have not been published. Due to the length, the family history will be limited. However, it must be a family history (i.e., involve more than one individual). Biographies, memoirs and edited documents will not be considered.

When Submissions will be received through June 30, 1999.

How Submissions must include an entry form (below). Please provide a short statement of your genealogical research experience. This may include, but is not limited to, how long you have been involved with research, your primary interests, and the libraries or repositories used in the research.

Please send three copies of the article. The title page should include the title only to ensure confidentiality in judging. The author's name must not be located anywhere in the article.

Students must submit proof of current enrollment in high school or in nine (9) semester hours of college.

Submissions not meeting the above requirements will not be considered.

For assurance of receipt, send manuscript by certified mail with return receipt requested through the U.S. Postal Service or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard which will be mailed to you as a receipt document.

Records of Rev. J. H. Williams

Logan, Franklin and Sebastian Counties

Submitted by Gay Williams, granddaughter, 8713 Sky Park Dr., Fort Smith, AR 72903, who states Rev. Williams served as minister in the Cumberland Presbyterian Church.

Joseph Hamilton (J. H.) Williams lived most of his life in Logan County. He was born in Arkansas 2 Jan 1872, son of John Lewis Williams (b. 15 Feb 1836, d. 28 Dec 1906, buried Glendale Cemetery) and Martha Jane Baker (b. 15 Apr 1846?, d. 15 July 1877, buried Glendale).

In the early 1890s, J. H. Williams married Alva Retta Terwilliger, b. 25 Dec 1874, d. 22 Dec 1962. They had four children: Claude who m. Fannie M. Howard; Dewey who m. 1) Donnie Whitman, m. 2) Carrie Ferguson, m. 3) Jimmie Lee Lowe; Ethel who m. Montie Lee Crossland; and Lydia who m. Clell Phillips.

J. H. Williams was ordained a minister in the Cumberland Presbyterian Church by the Fort Smith Presbytery at Coop Prairie near Mansfield on 28 Feb 1910. In those days, many ministers would pastor several different churches, preaching at each one Sunday a month. They usually traveled on horseback or by buggy.

Rev. J. H. Williams' journal records indicate that he preached at the following churches in the Logan/Franklin/Sebastian County area during the years from 1910 to 1953: Marietta, Liberty, Lone Star, Greenwood, Earl Prairie, Old Union, Mountain Springs, Pleasant Ridge, Fair Hill, Antioch, Zan, Shaver, Magazine, : Pilot Prairie, Ione, Cauthron, Porter, Green

Ridge, Union, White Bluff, Sugar Grove, Barber, Mud Fork, Ratcliff, Lucas, Caulksville, Pine Log, Walnut Grove, Lyles Chapel, Eagle Ridge, McKindree, Booneville, Dripping Springs, Union Valley and Coop Prairie.

His journal also contains records of marriages he performed and funerals he conducted during these years, which are included here. The spelling of names may be questionable, but the information is presented as he recorded it.

Rev. Joseph Hamilton Williams died 22 May 1962. He is buried in Pleasant Ridge Cemetery in Sebastian County (in the Fort Chaffee area).

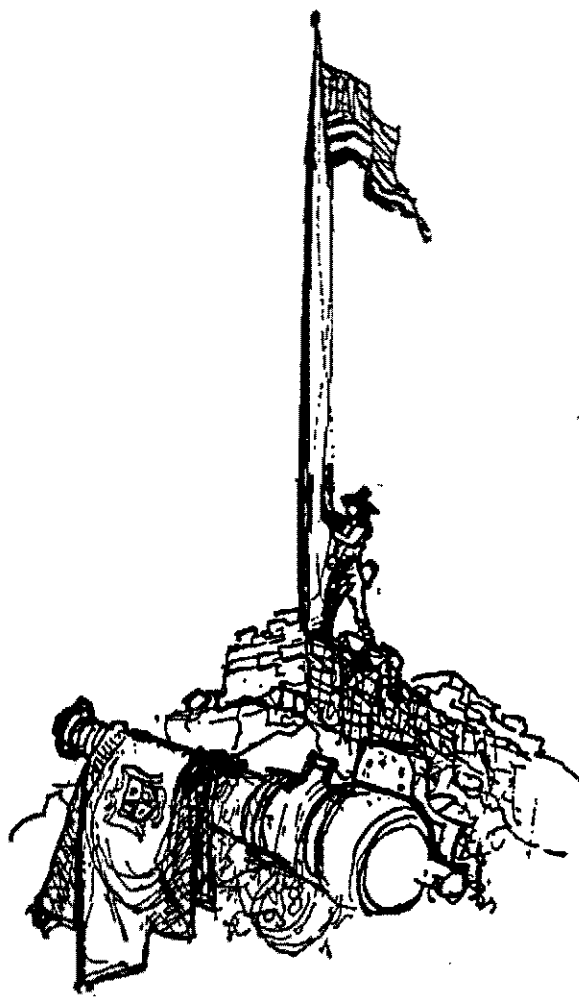

Index of Death Notices Appearing in the Arkansas Gazette 1919 (1998) by Oscar G. Russell, 506 Loop Rd., North Little Rock, AR 72120-2215. 272 plus pages, soft cover- \$31, hard bound-\$45. This is the latest in Mr. Russell's many indexes to death notices from Little Rock's *Arkansas Gazette*. This one contains 7,472 entries from both the "daily column" and various other news stories in this newspaper. Each notice contains the full name of the deceased, the town and state of residence at the time of death, plus age and date of death. A full citation is also provided, with page, column and date. These notices are not limited to deaths in Arkansas. The author also includes deaths reported from other states, as well as several foreign countries. 1919 was an important year because of the troop draw-down following World War I. Camp Pike, now Camp Robinson, located in North Little Rock, was still in full operation at the time. This index contains the death notices of many young men stationed there who died from pneumonia and meningitis.

Over 295 pages, soft cover \$21, hard bound \$34. Mr. Russell continues his tireless efforts to provide indexes to Little Rock newspapers. This offering contains the full name of each deceased, if included in the death notice, as well as residence at time of death, age, and a full citation to page and column. Entries have been taken from both the daily obituary column and from the many general news stories. Most notices are for deaths in the U.S. However, those occurring in a few foreign countries are included if carried in this newspaper. One can only encourage Mr. Russell to keep up the good work. [RPB]

Cherokee Connections an introduction to genealogical sources pertaining to Cherokee Ancestors (reprint 1998), by Myra Vanderpool Gormley, 64 pages, maps, illustrations, bibliography and index; soft cover \$9.95, plus postage. Order from Genealogical Publishing Company, Inc., 1001 N. Calvert St., Baltimore, MD 21202-3897. It is ironic that one of the most popular ethnic groups Americans want to do genealogical research on are "Native Americans", especially the Cherokees. At the same time this kind of family history research is usually among the hardest and most frustrating of all genealogical projects. Ms. Gormley has authored a little pamphlet that is crammed full of very useful

information. One of her first statements is : Are your families listed as *white* in [1900-1929 federal census]? If so, you have your work cut out for you." This inexpensive work is must reading BEFORE anyone embarks upon a research for their "Cherokee Princess". Otherwise the researcher will not know the Dawes Rolls from his intruders lists. [RPB]

Genealogical Starter Kit, 2nd Edition (1998), by William Dollarhide, 28 pages, soft cover, \$9.95 plus postage. Order from Genealogical Publishing Company, Inc., 1001 N. Calvert St., Baltimore, MD 21202-3897. This little book is not what you expect at first blush. It is not just a set of genealogy forms, but a small work packed with some of the answers to the questions every novice family historian has or will ask. It begins with a section entitled "What do you know?" and moves on to "What do you need to start"?, etc. Much of the remainder of the work is devoted to listings of names and locations of places where researchers can obtain genealogical data, such as birth/death certificates, county records, newspaper files, etc. The principal archival institution of each state is discussed, plus a few other local libraries and archives with "good" genealogical collections: however, new researchers should note that this list is far from comprehensive. For Arkansas he mentions the Arkansas "State" History Commission, the "one-stop place for research in Arkansas, plus the entire South" the University of Arkansas Libraries at Fayetteville; and the Southwest Arkansas Regional Archives at Washington, AR. The author closed his book with a small selection for his famous pedigree and family group sheets, with somewhat limited

instructions on how to complete each. [RPB]

Kershner Kinfolk, Volume 16, Library Edition for 1998, published by The Kershner Family Association, 1449 Fox Run Dr., Charlotte, NC 28212-7125, and edited by W. E. Kershner, has been received.
