Ancestry Expands Its Arkansas Collections

The cause of death is listed as Broncho pneumonia. Both forms include fields for personal and statistical data, medical certificate, and signatures of the attending physician and witnesses.

The site to search is <https://www.judyrecords.com/> and is free. No sign up is needed. Among the types of cases you'll find are adoption, divorces, marriages, estate files, and probate. About 10 million cases will be added each month. Information provided is basic, but it might lead you to other more detailed information.
